WHAT WE OFFER


Dear Breeders,

Our clinic is now able to offer a wide range of services for Registered Breeders, in order to make their job easier, more profitable - and more importantly, safer. We have renovated our clinic to accommodate these services, to set up a state of the art Reproduction Department.

At present, we are the only clinic specialising in canine reproduction North of the River.

Our services include....

- **Progesterone Testing** - Essential for timing of mating, and elective caesarians.
- **Vaginoscopy** - To aid in determination of the timing of mating (detection of ovulation).
- **Vaginal Cytology** - An aid in determination of the timing of mating.
- **T.C.I** - Transcervical insemination
- **A.I** - Vaginal insemination
- **Pregnancy Ultrasound** - Usually performed on Day 28 of pregnancy, or shortly after. This confirms a visual pregnancy, and aids in determining the date of birth.
- **Elective and Emergency Caesareans** - By a combination of ultrasound and progesterone testing, with our experience we are able to plan an elective caesarian. (See [this link](#) for more information)



ELECTIVE CAESERIANS

Whether it be a planned caesarean, or an emergency caesarean - you can count on the team at Belridge Vet to provide the highest quality of care for your animal and her offspring.

We recommend an elective caesarean if....

- High risk breeds (especially brachycephalic - pugs, frenchies, etc)
- Large litters (more than 9 pups)
- Small litters (1-2 pups)
- Bitches with pelvic disorders
- Bitches with any form of illness that may cause problems with birth
- Uterine infection
- Highly valuable puppies
- Bitches predisposed to develop dystonia (difficulty giving birth) - e.g. oversize puppies



T.C.I (TRANSCERVICAL INSEMINATION)

Commonly referred to as T.C.I , transcervical insemination is a procedure that is performed with the dog conscious and standing. Whereby a specialized endoscope is passed into the vagina to enable visualization of the cervix. This method allows semen to be passed through the cervix and into the uterus directly.

In comparison to surgical insemination, which requires the dog to be fully anaesthetised with the uterus externalized - semen is then injected into the uterus.

Transcervical insemination is considered to be a far more ethical and safer procedure than surgical insemination.

We offer this service in-house, using state of the art equipment.
